

Virginia Law Foundation Awards Grant to DTW

Drive-To-Work received a \$10,000 grant from the Virginia Law Foundation, which will help expand representation for underserved individuals.

At a luncheon on August 20 at the Virginia Museum of History & Culture, the VLF announced that it awarded \$753,000 to 34 organizations this year. Since the grants program began in 1984, the foundation has given more than \$30 million to support initiatives and nonprofits across Virginia. The grants advance the foundation's mission to uphold the Rule of Law, expand access to justice, and enhance law-related education.
